Double object constructions with different classes of verbs, "give", "send" and "show".

The theory on the basis of English data, predicts that different classes of verbs allow different argument order.

Verbs like "send" are predicted to prefer the order accusative-dative. Whereas, verbs like "give" and "show" are predicted to equally allow the two orders (accusative-dative) and (dative-accusative).

Research question: is there a correlation between the occurrence of verb types and the order of the arguments across verb classes in Croatian?


DATA AND METHODS


corpus used: Croatian Web (hrWaC 2.2, RFTagger) searched with Sketch
Engine which consists of 1,211,328,660 words

The results for Croatian are that the relation between the case order and verb classes are insignificant.
